Instruments with thin end-windows, as shown below, should be shipped by GROUND.





If shipped by **AIR**, these Geiger tubes should be packaged inside an airtight container, such as a paint can, to ensure that the window does not rupture at reduced pressures aloft.

Instruments with Attached Radioactive Check Sources.





1. The easy way.

Remove the 4 screws and store screws and the check source in a safe place. Replace the check source when the instrument is returned. If you do not replace the check source, remove the holder entirely.

2. The hard way. 1

- A. Do not ship via USPS or UPS
- B. Print the UN2910 label to the right on a color printer or use a pre-printed label.
- C. Apply the label to the outside of the package. The label shown is the right size.
- D. In the REFERENCE box on the Air Waybill, enter the Proper Shipping Name EXACTLY as shown:

UN2910
RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL – EXCEPTED PACKAGE
LIMITED QUANTITY OF MATERIAL

- E. Pray that FedEx doesn't bounce the package anyway.
- F. If the package is to be returned to your home someone must be there to receive it.
